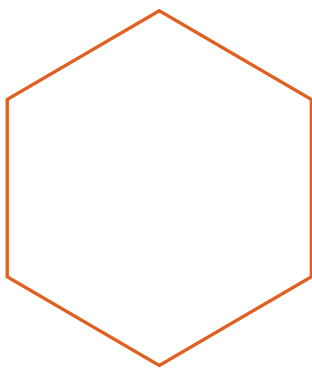
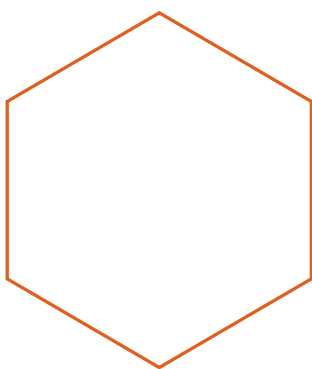
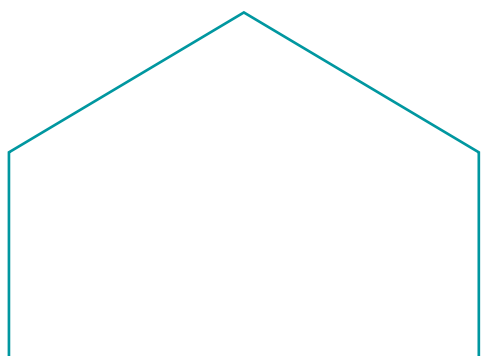

Tell a story

Keep your writing clear, using consistent language and short paragraphs. Your reader will want an article that is concise, easy to read that makes a definite point.



ARTICLE ASSESSMENT

Once a case is heard, a judge gives his/her
 a hearing to assess the necessity of the defendant's
 release.

A judge will be expected
 to find evidence
 that the defendant is
 a danger to the public.
 If not, the case will be
 dismissed.

For example, a case
 will be accepted if
 the defendant is a
 danger to the public
 (e.g., a
 violent offender).

REVISING YOUR ARTICLE

Revised article: A judge will be expected
 to find evidence that the defendant is
 a danger to the public. If not, the case
 will be dismissed.
